

## **Magic Spell Competition Rules**

- The competition is open to any primary school pupils in P4, P5, P6 and P7, or Year
   4, Year 5 and Year 6 only one entry per pupil.
- Spells must be original, but they can consist of real or imaginary ingredients.
- The entrant's name, school address and primary class/year must be written clearly on the entry form
- On the first page, draw and clearly label the spell ingredients you are using
   colouring these with pens or painting them will make them stand out!
- Spell instructions and spell effects (good, bad, magical, funny, scary be imaginative!) can be more than one page long (the entry form is just to give a rough guide of format) – please staple together any loose sheets to the pupil's entry to ensure these are not lost.
- The winner will receive a magic trick set and certificate.
- Five runners-up will receive a crystal growing set and certificate.
- Ten highly commended entrants will receive a certificate and a set of 'magic' colour change pens.
- Twenty commended entrants will receive a certificate and a Hag Storm keyring.

Here are some of the items that were in the poultice bag that put a spell on Rab's family at Halloween:




Deadly Nightshade

Deathwatch Beetle - dried in an East wind and ground to dust




Magpie Feather

field of autumn




Raven's Claw - taken from a bird in midflight and sharpened with a silver blade
